AUTOMATIC EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

In accordance with Article 3(5)(a) of the International Agreement on Taxation and the Protection of Financial Interests between the Kingdom of Spain and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, regarding Gibraltar the Income Tax Office is required to exchange information automatically in relation to residents of Spain registered in Gibraltar and engaged in employment or a trade, business, profession or vocation in or from Gibraltar.

Please note that the year of assessment in Gibraltar runs from 1 July to 30 June and therefore, based on the residential address data held, I confirm that information within the following broad categories will be shared by the Income Tax Office pursuant to obligations regarding automatic exchange of information under the Agreement for the taxable period 1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021.
